





Studio with a view of the Baltic Sea

This small studio in Rewal on the Baltic Sea proves that flats don't always have to be big to be convincing, in a beautiful, preferred location: namely directly on the waterfront.

It should be simple. Nevertheless noble and elegant. In addition, the flat owners wanted simple modern furnishing solutions. Combining these obvious contrasts was achieved through the skilful use of mainly grey and black surfaces and natural materials. In this way, not only was the existing potential of the small flat – namely the large window areas – optimally used, but the wishes for a restrained colour scheme were also met. The wood laminate lends the interior warmth and cosiness and refers to the surrounding nature.



The mirrored surfaces in the flat catch the eye. In order not to give too much weight to the dominant colours, many mirrors or glass surfaces were used. They visually enlarge the central space – an open-plan living room with kitchen – loosen up and cleverly exploit the natural light that enters through the large glass surfaces. And reflect the play of colours in nature and the fantastic view of the sea.

The smooth acrylic fronts from the RAUVISIO brilliant matt collection blend perfectly into the harmonious overall picture and more than live up to the call for simple modern solutions. The simple elegance is convincing. This is how living dreams come true.
